Pakistan's Proposal on Coordination, follow-up and evaluation Mechanism

The CDIP Chairman's summary to include following recommendations for the consideration by the General Assembly regarding coordination, follow-up- and evaluation of the Development Agenda recommendations:

- The General Assembly to instruct all WIPO Committees to mainstream all Development Agenda recommendations in their work
- Request the Director General to make opening remarks at the start of the
 forthcoming SCP, SCCR, IGC on GRTKF, PBC, SCT, ACE, SCIT and
 Assemblies meetings. In his remarks, the Director General may emphasize
 adherence to and implementation of the Development Agenda recommendations
 by the respective bodies.
- All reports/studies/documents/negotiating texts prepared by the Secretariat (or the consultants) should be in accordance with the cluster B, in particular recommendation 22 of the Development Agenda.
- Chairs/Presidents of SCP, SCCR, IGC on GRTKF, PBC, SCT, ACE, SCIT and the Assemblies in their report to the General Assembly, with the assistance of the Secretariat, include how their respective Bodies have implemented the Development Agenda recommendations.
- Member States, in the General Assembly, may give guidance to the Chairs/Presidents of different Bodies for effective implementation of the Development Agenda recommendations, if any.
- "Review of implementation of Development recommendations" may be included as Agenda item on the Agenda of the General Assembly.
