

Draft Resolution on Agenda Item 11.20:

***Sub-standard, spurious, falsely-labelled, falsified, counterfeit medical products***

The sixty-third World Health Assembly:

Decides to establish an open-ended inter-governmental working group comprising Member States;

Requests the Director General to facilitate the work of the inter-governmental working group;

Decides that the working group will examine the following issues:

- (i) measures to ensure access to quality, safe, efficacious and affordable medical products;
- (ii) relationship between WHO and IMPACT;
- (iii) prevention and control of medical products of compromised quality, safety and efficacy such as sub-standard, spurious, falsely-labelled, falsified, counterfeit medical products from a public health perspective, excluding trade and intellectual property considerations;
- (iv) issues raised in the proposals in (a) A 63/ A/ Conf. Papers no. 4. Rev. 1, (b) A 63/ A/ Conf. Paper no. 5 and (c) A63/ A/ Conf. Paper no. 7.

Decides that the working group shall make specific recommendation in relation to the above issues and report to the 64<sup>th</sup> WHA through the 128<sup>th</sup> session of the Executive Board.
