Draft Resolution on Agenda Item 11.20:

Sub-standard, spurious, falsely-labelled, falsified, counterfeit medical products

The sixty-third World Health Assembly:

Decides to establish an open-ended inter-governmental working group comprising Member States;

Requests the Director General to facilitate the work of the inter-governmental working group;

Decides that the working group will examine the following issues:

- (i) measures to ensure access to quality, safe, efficacious and affordable medical products;
- (ii) relationship between WHO and IMPACT;
- (iii) prevention and control of medical products of compromised quality, safety and efficacy such as sub-standard, spurious, falsely-labelled, falsified, counterfeit medial products from a public health perspective, excluding trade and intellectual property considerations;
- (iv) issues raised in the proposals in (a) A 63/ A/ Conf. Papers no. 4. Rev. 1,
 (b) A 63/ A/ Conf. Paper no. 5 and (c) A63/ A/ Conf. Paper no. 7.

Decides that the working group shall make specific recommendation in relation to the above issues and report to the 64th WHA through the 128th session of the Executive Board.
