Objectives - Proposal from the African Group 28 October 2011

Takes care of paragraphs 16, 12, 7

1) To identify major needs and challenges and develop policy recommendations, and tools and training in the area of prevention, detection and control of SSFFC products in order to strengthen national and regional efforts including the integrity of the supply.

Takes care of paragraphs 8, 9, 15

- 3) To exchange experiences, lessons learnt, best practices, information, including the creation of database, advocacy on ongoing activities at national and regional evels.
- 11) To facilitate consultation, cooperation and collaboration with relevant stakeholders in a transparent and coordinated manner.
- 4) To strengthen regulatory capacity including quality control laboratories at national and regional level in, particular for developing countries and LDCs.
- 13) To promote cooperation and collaboration on surveillance and monitoring of SSFFC medical products.
- 14) To further work on a harmonized definition of SSFFC medical products that focuses on the protection of public health and takes into account the need to safeguard legitimate generic medicines.
