## INFORMAL NON-PAPER

SCP/21: FUTURE WORK PROPOSAL (REVISED)

November 7, 2014

- 1. The non-exhaustive list of issues will remain open for further elaboration and discussion at the next session of the SCP.
- 2. Without prejudice to the mandate of the SCP, the Committee agreed that its work for the next session (SCP/22) be confined to fact-finding and not lead to harmonization at this stage, and would be carried out as follows:
  - (1) Exceptions and Limitations to Patent Rights
    - Compilation of Member States' experiences and case studies on the effectiveness of exceptions and limitations, in particular, in addressing development issues
  - (2) Quality of Patents, including Opposition Systems
    - Seminar on quality of patents to address perspectives on what quality means, and to identify needs and requirements for developing capacity for patent search and examination
    - Seminar on work sharing and collaboration to share experiences
    - Studies on inventive step and sufficiency of disclosure as agreed at SCP/20
  - (3) Patents and Health
    - Seminar on the relationship between patent systems and availability of medicines, in particular, in developing countries and LDCs
    - Continue discussions on disclosure of INN (document SCP/21/9)
  - (4) Confidentiality of communications between clients and their patent advisors
    - Compilation of information from Member States concerning applying confidentiality protection to non-lawyers and equal treatment to national and foreign patent advisors
  - (5) Transfer of Technology
    - Compilation of information from Member States on national/regional regulations, guidelines, and practices and jurisprudence regarding voluntary licenses.
