To the Ambassadors of Lisbon Union Members (Please see distribution list)

Excellencies,

A broad range of World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) members, including a current member of the Lisbon Agreement, have expressed concerns that the Diplomatic Conference for the Adoption of a Revised Lisbon Agreement on Appellations of Origin and Geographical Indications would not be open for full and equal participation by all WIPO members.

Singapore shares these concerns. We had earlier supported a proposal for the Rules of Procedure of the Diplomatic Conference to be amended to allow for full and equal participation by all WIPO Members. This was done on the principle that transparency and inclusiveness are fundamental to the good working and credibility of WIPO and is especially relevant when what many consider to be a substantive change to a WIPO Treaty is now being contemplated. However, this proposal was rejected by the Preparatory Committee for the Diplomatic Conference held on 30-31 October 2014.

Singapore's concerns over the systemic impact and precedence setting value of a closed Lisbon Diplomatic Conference remain current. Singapore notes that for the past 25 years, WIPO Diplomatic Conferences have been open to all WIPO Members. Singapore therefore wishes to reiterate our concern that any Diplomatic Conference which does not allow for full and equal participation of all WIPO members is inconsistent with WIPO's historically inclusive and consensus-based approach to international norm setting.

Singapore encourages you as a Lisbon Member to reconsider the option of an open Diplomatic Conference allowing for full and equal participation, and looks forward to the WIPO Membership finding an acceptable compromise that would meet the concerns and interests of all sides.
