



US-BASED MULTINATIONAL PHARMACEUTICAL AND TOBACCO COMPANIES USE NEW TRADE DEAL TO THREATEN PUBLIC HEALTH LEGISLATION

EMBARGOED UNTIL 12 NOON SUNDAY, 16 JANUARY 2011

US-based multinational pharmaceutical companies are lobbying for Trans-Pacific Partnership Agreement (TPPA) provisions similar to those in the Australia-US Free Trade Agreement, which would reduce cost-effective government regulatory control of pharmaceuticals, threatening equitable access to medicines, according to an article in the *Medical Journal of Australia*.

The TPPA is a multilateral free trade agreement (now at the final stages of negotiation) aimed at increasing economic integration in the Asia-Pacific region.

Assoc Prof Thomas Faunce, ARC Future Fellow at the College of Law and College of Medicine, Biology and the Environment at the Australian National University, and co-author elucidated the likely content and impact of the upcoming TPPA negotiations and the policy implications they would have on Australia and the region's public health and medicines policy.

Prof Faunce identified three issues that have been discussed during TPPA negotiations that would have significant public health and medicine policy implications for Australia:

- ways to approach regulatory coherence and transparency;
- how to benefit multinational and small-medium enterprises(SMEs); and
- multilateral investor-state dispute settlement.

Prof Faunce said that US-based multinational pharmaceutical companies were lobbying for TPPA provisions, which would limit the development of Australian generic medicine enterprises and restrict patient access to cheap, bioequivalent prescription drugs. He said that, US-base tobacco companies were also lobbying for provisions that would impede public health legislation such as plain packaging of cigarettes.

"Of particular concern is that proposed TPPA multilateral investor—state dispute settlement procedures would allow US corporations, as well as those of other nations, to obtain damages against Australian governments through international arbitral proceedings if their investments are impeded by Australian public health and environment protection legislation." Prof Faunce said.

"This will severely impede the capacity of our public health regulators to apply the precautionary principle in relation to hazardous chemicals and products

"Rather than acceding to these demands Australia TPPA negotiators have a responsibility both to this nation and our developing neighbours to promote regulatory coherence on comparative cost-effectiveness research on new drugs, as well as stronger anti-monopoly and anti-fraud laws for the Australian pharmaceutical sector."





Thank you very much! I spoke with Katsumata san this week regarding the TPP Presentation.

The likely venue will be an international meeting auditorium in the Diel Office Building.

They are expecting roughly 100 Diet members to attend, but they do not know exactly how many will be there yet. They will let us know as we get closer.

Katsumata san recommended that the presentation be 20 minutes, to allow for 40 minutes of Q/A and discussion.

We have arranged for simultaneous translation from Simul.

Here are the key points that Katsumata san would like your remarks to cover:

- 1. What is TPP? What does it mean for Asia?
- 2. Why is Japan's participation essential?
- 3. Some people in Japan have said that agriculture will be sacrificed, but that Japan will not really gain very much in return. How should we think about this?
- 4. Does the US really want Japan in TPP?
- 5. Some people in Japan say that the reason Japan is not competitive is not because of tariffs but rather because of exchange rates. What will change if tariffs are lowered (meaning, how will lowering tariffs increase competit iveness)?
- 6. What is the merit for Japan in joining TPP? How is success defined?

The event is entirely off the record.

I think the slides that you have drafted track well with these points.

I have read the invitation to the event, which was sent out by Tarutoko san and Katsumata san. It is very good -- the text describes you as a true expert on the subject, having spent many years at USTR and working closely (supervising) key officials who are currently still there. (The flyer was written and sent by the Diet members based on the bio we provided to them (they did not show it to me first, which is fine. It is well-composed.)

It may be better to not use the AdvaMed template, except towards the end when you make the point regarding advanced medical technology as an example.

The template brands the text as AdvaMed points, but I think it may be better to have them framed as your own observations, based on your long experience negotiating trade agreements as a former senior US trade official. Then towards the end you can link into some observations from the perspective of the advanced medical technology industry, which you currently represent as EVP of AdvaMed – or a flow similar to that.

It may be good to find a handshake graphic that is visually even – this one appears that the hand on the left is reaching from above to the hand on the right, which is positioned slightly lower. Since there is a perception among doubters in Japan that the US may get the upper hand via TPP, I think an even handshake may be best – I will look for one.

I just returned from Tokyo this morning (am sending this email from the car heading home), Saturday, and will be here in DC for the next two weeks (can meet or speak via phone at any time). We can set up a pre-trip briefing based on your schedule if you would like.






